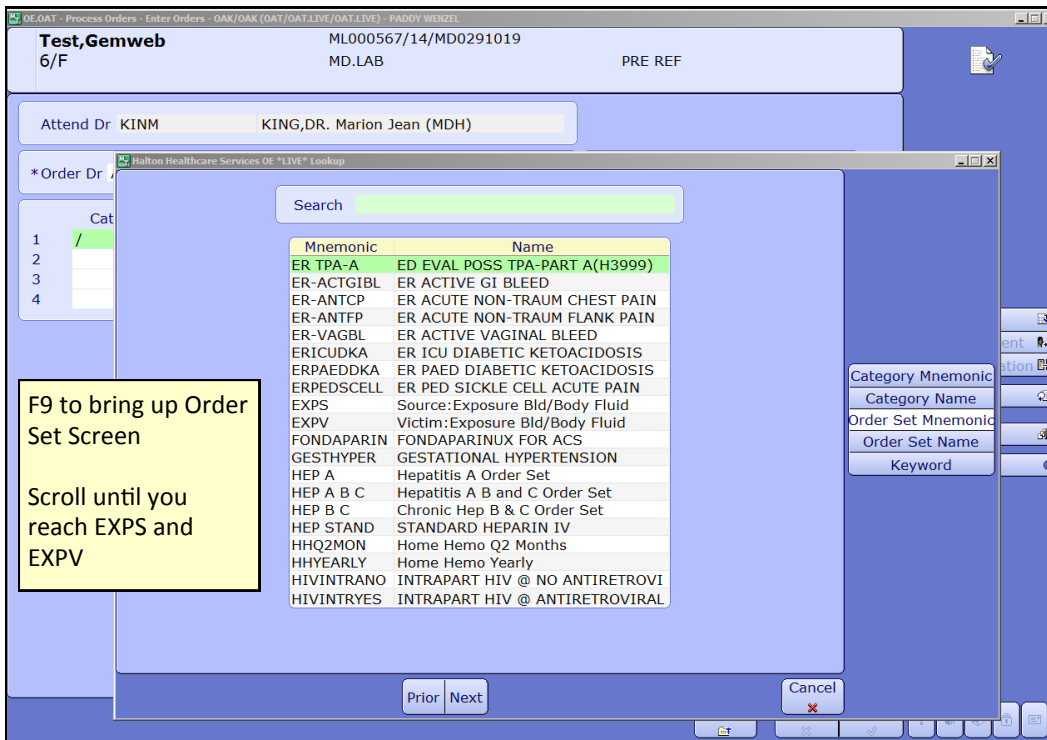
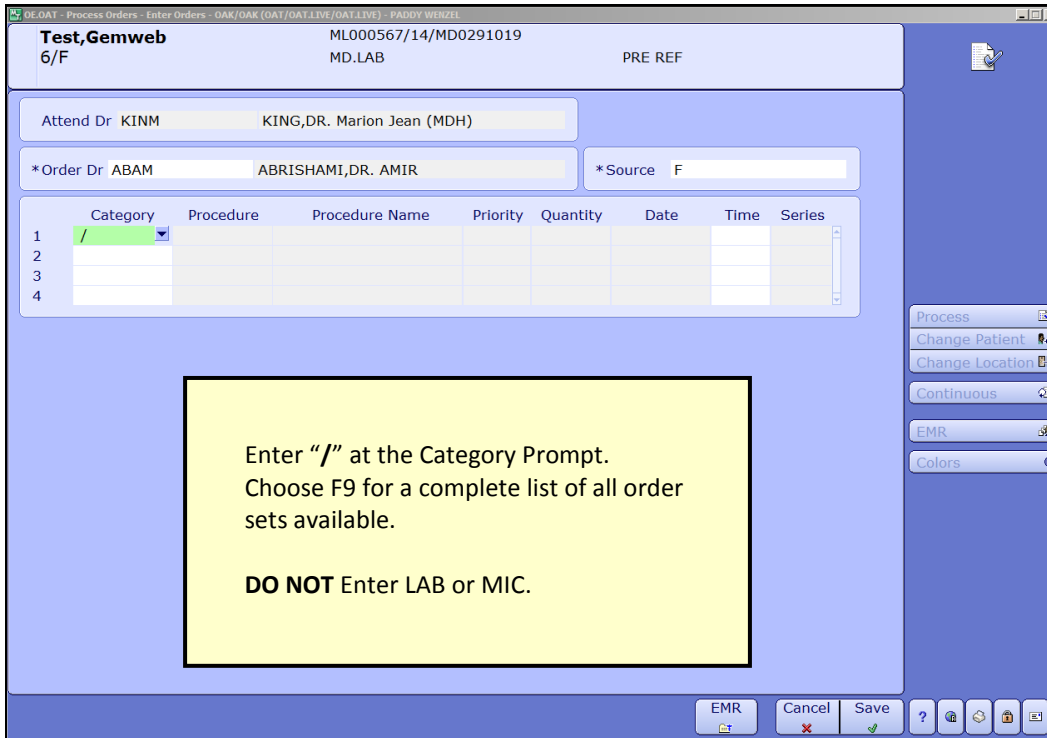


## How to order Exposure Order Sets

1. In Order Entry (OE) at the Category prompt enter “/” and then “F9”. This brings up an order set look up screen. Scroll down to either **EXPV** (Exposure Victim) or **EXPS** (Exposure Source).

**NOTE: DO NOT** enter either LAB or MIC as you cannot reach the order sets afterwards.

2. **EXPV**: is for the person hurt by e.g. needlestick, bite, or a splash to mucous membranes.
3. **EXPS**: is for the person that bit/spit at the victim, or from whom the needle originally came from.
